RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Simpson United Methodist Church has applied to the Old Bridge Municipal Utilities Authority for Minor Approval in connection with its Water Application #W12-631 known as Simpson United Methodist Church located on the south side of Route 516 at Owens Road, Block 15000/Lot 17 and Block 15587/Lot 142 (2.8 acres); and

WHEREAS, the Applicant proposes to construct approximately 180 linear feet of six (6) and eight (8) inch DIP water main together with a fire hydrant which will connect into the existing water main located on Owens Road; and

WHEREAS, the existing water service line will be replaced and service the existing church/office and proposed addition with a net increase of 625 square feet; and


WHEREAS, the proposed addition is being added to relocate the kitchen and offices from the basement area of the church which will be converted to a crawl space due to recurrent flooding; and

WHEREAS, the Staff Engineer has reviewed the project and reports submitted, has recommended Minor Approval in accordance with his report dated May 16, 2014;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the Old Bridge Municipal Utilities Authority ("OBMUA") that the Application for Minor Approval in connection with Water Application No. W12-631 known as Simpson United Methodist Church be and the same is hereby granted subject to the following conditions:

- (1) The Applicant shall pay all applicable fees.
- (2) The Applicant shall comply with and address any and all comments in the Staff Engineer's report dated May 16, 2014.
- (3) All proposed water mains are to remain privately owned and maintained by the Applicant.
- (4) The Applicant shall schedule a pre-construction meeting at least two (2) weeks prior to commencing any utility construction.
- (5) Wet cut fee, Performance Guarantee, Certificate of Insurance and proof of all required permits shall be submitted prior to the pre-construction meeting.
- (6) Lawn irrigation is not included in the approval, however, if lawn irrigation using municipal water is proposed in the future, the Applicant must submit a plan of same to the Authority for approval.
- (7) The Applicant shall construct the water improvements in accordance with the approved drawings and permits issued by any Agency having jurisdiction.
- (8) Applicant shall fully comply with the Rules and Regulations of the Authority and any Agency having jurisdiction.
- (9) This Final Water Approval shall expire one (1) year from the date of the resolution if no construction has taken place within that one (1) year period.


WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law allows a public agency to extend contracts pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-15; and
