Notwithstanding the foregoing, should such deceased employee's spouse remarry, then the Authority will have no obligation to continue to offer said benefits to said spouse.

- 3. All persons qualifying under this Resolution shall be required, when eligible, to make application for any federal or state benefits under any program offered, including but not limited to Medicare Plans A and B, with the express purpose of reducing or eliminating the cost of group health plans to the Authority. Schneider Electric is requiring payment for the past three years of support in the amount of \$16,204.74 for a total amount of \$21,606.32 to reinstate the agreement; and

WHEREAS, the agreement is for the provision or performance of goods and services for the support or maintenance of proprietary computer software, and is exempt from public bidding pursuant to N.J.S.A.40A:11-5(dd); and

WHEREAS, funds are or will be available for this purpose; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the Old Bridge Municipal Utilities Authority that Guy Donatelli, Executive Director is hereby authorized to execute an Agreement with Schneider Electric in the amount of \$21,606.32 for a one (1) year term. The Agreement will be effective from October 1, 2022 through September 30, 2023;
