

Construction of upgrades and improvements to the Old Bridge Municipal Utilities Authority Distribution System were financed by the New Jersey Water Bank (NJWB). The total project costs are estimated to be \$4,443,000. The NJWB is a State Revolving Fund program jointly administered by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and the New Jersey Infrastructure Bank (NJIB) and uses a combination of funds provided by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, the DEP, and the NJIB to provide very low interest loans to borrowers for environmental infrastructure projects.

This project will provide water quality benefits by relocating and replacing water services from outdated and undersized mains to larger mains, which will create increased resiliency and efficiency for residents and businesses in the Laurence Harbor area of Old Bridge
