WHEREAS, there was one (1) bid received for Section 3 of the contract. Ferguson Waterworks, Howell, N.J. was the lone bidder for this section with a total contract price of \$220,835.97, representing a decrease of five-point two percent (5.2%) from the prior year; and

WHEREAS, there was one (1) bid received for Section 4 of the contract. Ferguson Waterworks, Howell, N.J. was the lone bidder for this section with a total contract price of \$349,684.17, representing a decrease of twenty-four-point nine percent (24.9%) from the prior year; and

WHEREAS, there were two (2) bids received for Section 5 of the contract. Ferguson Waterworks, Howell, N.J. was the lowest responsible bidder for this section with a total contract price of \$157,715.96, representing an increase of three-point-six percent (3.6%) from the prior year; and

WHEREAS, there was one (1) bid received for Section 6 of the contract. Ferguson Waterworks was the lone bidder for this section with a total contract price of \$242,143.21, representing a decrease of four-point-six percent (4.6%) from the prior year; and

WHEREAS, there was one (1) bid received for Section 8 of the contract. Ferguson Waterworks was the lone bidder for this section with a total contract price of \$95,870.71, representing an increase of twelve-point-six percent (12.6%) over the prior year; and

WHEREAS, there was one (1) bid received for Section 9 of the contract. Ferguson Waterworks, Howell, N.J. was the lone bidder for this section with a total contract price of \$14,532.70, representing a decrease of seven-point-one percent (7.1%) over the prior year; and

WHEREAS, there were no bids received for Section 2 and Section 7 of the contract. The Authority will utilize price quotes, if products are needed for these sections, and attempt to obtain bids next year for these sections; and

WHEREAS, the Staff Engineer has recommended awarding the contracts for the above sections, for the unit prices bid, to the lowest bidder, Ferguson Waterworks, Howell, N.J. as indicated in his letter dated August 16, 2024;

WHEREAS, Nappi Trucking has been operating the property at 541 Morristown Road (Site) as a trucking facility since 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Site contained eight (8) underground storage tanks that contained various petroleum products. During the underground storage tank removal process, the soil samples showed levels of contamination in excess of acceptable limits, requiring the preparation of a Remedial Investigation Report and Remedial Action Workplan; and

WHEREAS, Middlesex County Utilities Authority (MCUA) has issued a temporary discharge permit to receive this groundwater at the treatment facility in Sayreville providing the groundwater is pre-treated prior to discharge in the sewer collection system to remove chemical levels that would be harmful to the MCUA's biological treatment process; and

WHEREAS, based on the necessity for Nappi Trucking to perform this soil remediation work and the permit limitations imposed by MCUA's temporary discharge permit, along with the short-term nature of this work, Michael Roy, Executive Director/Staff Engineer has recommended that groundwater discharge to the OBMUA's sewage collection be permitted on a temporary basis condition upon the following:

- 1. Payment, by Nappi Trucking, to the OBMUA for the quantity of discharged groundwater in accordance with the rate schedule.
- Compliance with the temporary discharge permit issued by the MCUA that includes pre-treatment and laboratory testing of the discharged groundwater.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the aforesaid recitals are incorporated herein as though fully set forth at length;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Commissioners of the Old Bridge Municipal Utilities Authority that temporary discharge approval from the Site into the OBMUA's sewer collection, by Nappi Trucking, is hereby approved;
