WHEREAS, the Old Bridge Municipal Utilities Authority (“OBMUA” or “Authority”) is a contract bulk purchaser of water from the Middlesex Water Company (MWC); and

WHEREAS, on October 7, 2024, the Middlesex Water Company (MWC) filed a petition with the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities (NJBPU) requesting a purchased water adjustment which will increase the cost of purchased water to the OBMUA; and

WHEREAS, the Marlboro Water Utility (“Township”) is also a contract bulk purchaser of water from the MWC and impacted by the proposed rate petition; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has partnered and shared costs with the Township (hereinafter) collectively referred to as the “Parties”; and

WHEREAS, the Parties are in need of professional services and/or legal and expert utility rate analysis; and

WHEREAS, the OBMUA has entered into agreements for the requisite professional services pursuant to the Local Public Contracts Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:11, et seq.); and

WHEREAS, the Parties wish to enter into a Shared Services Agreement for professional services for legal and expert utility rate analysis; and

WHEREAS, the Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1, et seq., permits, authorizes and encourages units of local government to share services for particular purposes and to effectuate agreements for any services or circumstances that will aid and encourage a reduction of local expenses; and

WHEREAS, the Parties are public bodies corporate and political in the State of New Jersey and are authorized under New Jersey Law to enter into a Shared Services Agreement pursuant to the Act; and

WHEREAS, the Parties have negotiated the terms of a Shared Services Agreement, a copy of which is annexed hereto and incorporated into this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best economic interest of the OBMUA rate payers and Township residents to enter into this Shared Services Agreement; and

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the OBMUA:

1. The above recitals are hereby incorporated into the body of this Resolution as if set forth at length herein.
2. The OBMUA hereby approves the Shared Services Agreement with the Township for legal and expert utility rate analysis services.
3. The OBMUA Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Authority's Executive Director to execute the Agreement with the Township in the form so approved.
4. The Agreement shall be open to public inspection in the administrative offices of the OBMUA and shall take effect upon the adoption of this resolution and execution of the Agreement by both parties.
5. A copy of the Agreement shall be filed, for informational purposes, with the Division of Local Government Services in the Department of Community Affairs.




